If you plan to leave your partner out of your Will, keep in mind they could challenge your Will because it falls under <u>The Family Protection Act</u> (FPA).

Note: A partner is defined as: a "de facto relationship". This is a relationship between two people, both aged 18 years or older; who "live together as a couple"; and who are not married to, or in a civil union with, each other. The definition is flexible because it relies on a high level of judicial discretion and takes a functional approach that looks at how a couple's relationship operates in practice rather than its form.
